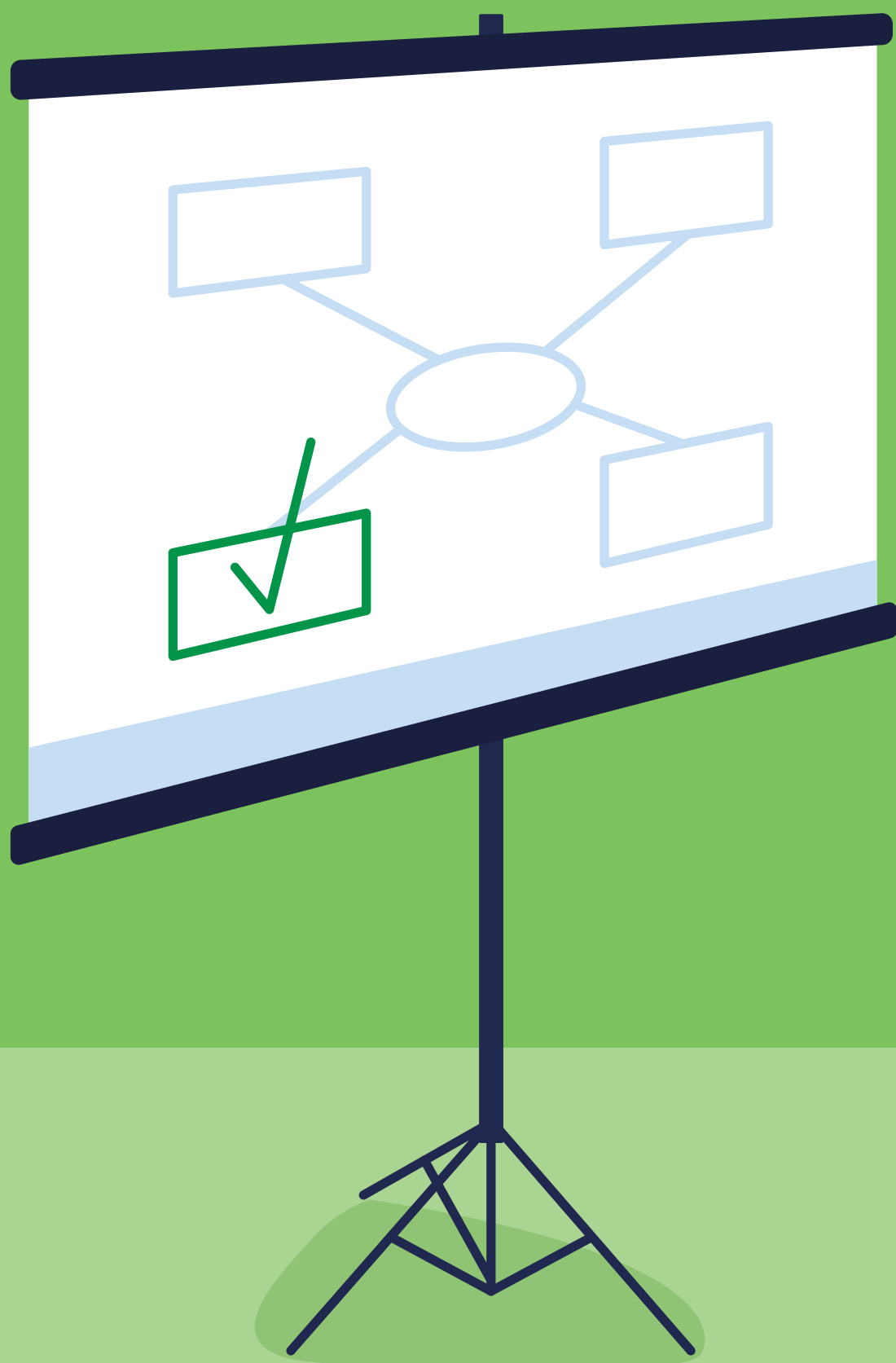
Equip learners in skills development with knowledge on their **rights, inclusive and respectful conduct, gender roles, and protection mechanisms** against violence and harassment.
